

Call for Presentations: 2023 RADx-UP Scientific Meeting

The next RADx-UP Scientific Meeting will take place virtually May 3, 2023.

The CDCC strongly encourages all RADx-UP project teams – from Phase I, Phase II, and the Community Collaboration Mini-Grant Program – to submit abstracts for either an oral presentation or a virtual poster session at the event.

A panel of community and academic reviewers will select eight or nine presentations that best demonstrate the overall mission and purpose of the RADx-UP program. These teams will be invited to give a 20-minute oral presentation. We will only review submissions related to RADx-UP data, and preference will be given to quantitative research-based submissions that report complete results.

Abstracts will be reviewed based on these guidelines:

- **Significance of research:** How does this research add to the understanding of health behaviors and health equity among underserved groups? What is the significance of the research findings to other RADx-UP project teams?
- **Innovation:** Does the research take a novel approach to studying a health behavior problem? Does the research use novel methods, instruments, or interventions?
- **Approach:** Is the overall research approach methodologically and analytically sound?
- Clarity of results: Are the results of the study clearly explained in the abstract? Do the results directly answer the research question or study purpose provided?
- Writing clarity: Is the writing free of inaccuracies and easy to read?

Each RADx-UP project team may submit one abstract/proposal. There are no limits on co-presenters, but each presentation must include a community partner or a representative of the underserved population addressed by your project.

If your abstract is accepted for presentation, it is expected that you and/or a copresenter will register for the RADx-UP Scientific Meeting and be present and on time for your session. Abstracts must be submitted by **Feb. 10, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. ET.**
