

PROJECT GOAL: Helping Pacific Islanders get tested for COVID-19 through learning sessions


IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON PACIFIC ISLANDERS IN HAWAII

Pacific Islanders (PI) in Hawai'i have been heavily affected by COVID-19. PI who have other health conditions, such as diabetes, high blood pressure, and obesity, are at increased risk of severe COVID-19. There is a need for COVID-19 testing responses for PI communities.


WHAT ARE THE STUDY RESULTS SO FAR?



IN THE BEGINNING OF THE STUDY...







Of 2992 PI participants, 2064 (69%) had been tested for COVID-19.

Most of the 2992 PI participants got COVID-19 information from...



DURING THE STUDY...

Of 1051 PI participants tested, 99% were NEGATIVE for COVID-19!
